Some workshops relate to statutory assessments that take place for different year groups over the year. Please see below information and dates for these assessments. We will provide you with further information at the parent sessions.

Phonics Screening Check

All children in Y1 will take the Phonics Screening Check which is designed to see if pupils have learnt phonic decoding and blending skills to an appropriate standard. The Phonics Screening Check will take place during the week commencing 10th June 2024.

KS1 SATS

Children in Year 2 will take part in a number of assessments for Reading, Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar, and Maths. Assessments will take place during May.

Y4 Multiplication Tables Check (MTC)

All children in Y4 will complete the statutory multiplication check which is an online check that assesses children's knowledge and rapid recall of the 1 - 12 times tables. The multiplication check takes place during a two week period from Monday 3rd June.

KS2 SATS

Y6 pupils will complete statutory end of Key Stage assessments in Reading, Spelling, Grammar and Punctuation, and Mathematics. Assessments will take place during the week of 13th May 2024.











It is essential that your child doesn't take any form of leave during these assessment periods.
