Maths

In Maths we will be continuing our learning on multiplication and division. We will then apply our learning to statistics and fractions.

Art and Design

Geography

Children will recall the locational knowledge of countries within the UK alongside looking at other major countries in each continent. We will be looking at the longest rivers, tallest mountains and tallest buildings.

Computing

Children will explore the concept of sequencing in programming y using Scratch. They will work towards the final project of creating a representation of a piano.
