

Maths

Children will continue their learning on fractions. Following on from this, they will build an understanding of money and decimals.

Computing

Children will develop an understanding of what a branching database is and how to create one. They will use yes/no questions to sort groups of objects.

English

Children will be producing diary entries, narratives, descriptions, interviews, letters and a critical analysis based on the book 'The Day I Was Erased' by Lisa Thompson.

RSHE

Children will be learning about the differences and similarities and how to treat people.

RE

Children will be looking at the ways that Jesus is important today.

Design Technology

Children will learn about the principles of a healthy and varied diet. They will use a range of equipment and utensils to prepare ingredients.

Music

Children will explore the rhythm and texture within a piece of music and learn to create music with a rhythmical texture.
