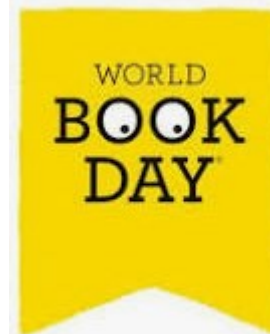
# Phonics

During Phonics, the children will continue to learn their nursery rhyme of the week and practise their listening skills in many different sound activities. Ask your child 'what sound does... start with? And you will be amazed! Please also let your child practise writing their name.

# M a t h s

In Maths, the children will be learning how to reliably count objects by carefully touching one at a time. They will also be challenged to find the matching numeral as well as showing their teachers using their fingers how many objects they have counted. The children will also be revisiting their learning on patterns as well as using and understanding positional language in their play. For example, can you put teddy under the table? And can you stand next to your friend? Our counting rhymes this half term are the ants go marching, 5 little bunnies and 5 little fish. Can they show you the correct number on their fingers as they sing you these songs?
