Geography

Children will study how animals and plants are adapted to ecosystems and biomes. Children will then apply their learning to design their own imaginary island.

Art

Children will develop attaching and cutting techniques whilst creating 3D models using different materials.

Computing

Children will make careful choices about font size, colour and type when editing and improving documents. They will be introduced to templates and place holders when publishing work and making a magazine cover.

Religious Education

Children will about a range of beliefs that people hold about God. They will look into both the Christian and Muslim religions.

Music

Children will create a graphic score for a piece of music they compose.

Physical Education

Children will develop their skills in the sports of tennis and rounders.

English

Children will be producing diary entries, narratives, descriptions, interviews, letters and a critical analysis based on the book 'The Day I Was Erased' by Lisa Thompson.

Maths

Children will continue their learning on money and decimals before moving onto telling the time and working out durations.

RSHE

Children will learn about personal information and how this is gathered and stored by websites. Children will also learn how germs are spread and how to keep healthy.

Science

Children will explore the idea that light travels in straight lines and apply this to different contexts whilst working like a scientist.
