Implementation Statement

All children across KS2 receive at least 30 minutes of foreign language teaching each week, focusing on French. Lessons are differentiated, taking into account the diverse needs and abilities of students, allowing each child to progress at their own pace. Our French curriculum is carefully designed to ensure progression, coherence, and coverage of key language skills, vocabulary, and grammar structures.

We use a wide range of authentic resources, including audio recordings, videos, songs, and texts, to expose students to real-life language use and promote cultural understanding. Opportunities for speaking and listening in French are maximised through regular interactions, dialogues, role-plays, and language-rich activities such as group discussions and presentations.

Our French curriculum is broken down into four sections which are covered each year in KS2, allowing children to remember more – listening, speaking, reading and writing.
