

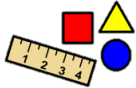

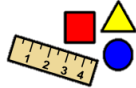

Maths

In Maths we will be learning about numbers and place value of numbers. Children will then use this learning to support them with the four operations – Addition, Subtraction, Multiplication and Division. Finally, children will begin their learning on measurement by looking at the area of shapes.

English

This six-week unit is focused on Anthony Browne's Zoo – an engaging picture book on the purpose of zoos and the relationship between animals and people. The learning journey will develop pupils' understanding of the story – its characters, themes, language and illustrations.



Art

Children will develop their drawing techniques when producing portraits. They will look at the work of Picasso during the unit and evaluate their own and others artwork.

Science

Children will learn that electricity flows through some materials, but not others. They will explore what happens when electricity flows through lamps, buzzers and motors, and learn that a complete circuit is needed for the electricity to flow.

PE

Children will receive 5 weeks of tennis coaching from a qualified coach from Chesterfield Tennis Centre. They will learn about their stance and different tennis techniques. They will also study netball, learning about different passes, positions and game strategies.

French

In French, children will focus on general classroom language alongside learning how to describe peoples personality and features.

Computing

In Computing, we will be looking at the internet and World Wide Web, understanding what networks are and learning who owns the content produced.

Music

Children will learn what a musical motif is before creating their own. They will use a form of notation to record a piece of music and practise singing together in time.

RE

Children will learn about the concept of 'Gospel'* which tells the story of the life and teaching of Jesus. They will learn about the calling of the first disciples and how Christians today try to follow Jesus.

RSHE

During this unit, pupils will look to answer the questions:
Are all friends the same?
Are friendships always fun?
Are we happy all the time?

History

This unit is focused on the impact of the Roman Empire on Britain. Children will learn about the Roman Invasion and Boudicca's rebellion before learning of the legacy left by the Romans.
