

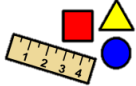


# Sycamore Class

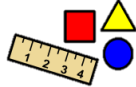

### Maths

In Maths we will be learning about numbers and place value of numbers. Children will then use this learning to support them with the four operations – Addition, Subtraction, Multiplication and Division. Finally, children will begin their learning on measurement by looking at the area of shapes.

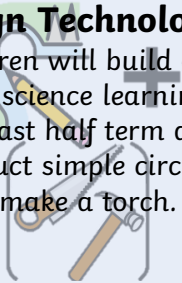
### English

This six-week unit of work immerses children in the story of C. S. Lewis's *The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe*. They will use the text to develop their reading comprehension, vocabulary and writing. The unit culminates in a final piece of work where the children apply all that they have learned in this story to create a non-chronological report to inform and guide a visitor to Narnia.



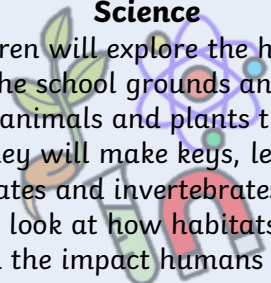
### Design Technology

Children will build on their science learning from last half term and construct simple circuits to make a torch.



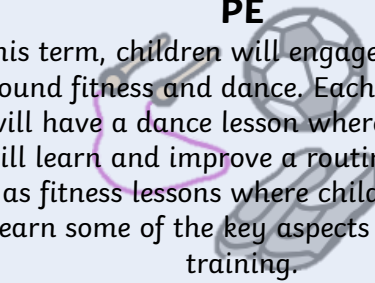
### Science

Children will explore the habitats within the school grounds and begin to group animals and plants that they find. They will make keys, learn what vertebrates and invertebrates are and finally look at how habitats change and the impact humans have.



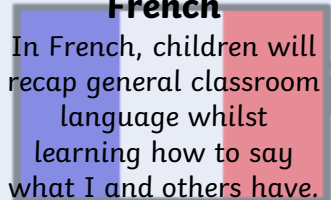
### PE

This term, children will engage in lessons around fitness and dance. Each week they will have a dance lesson where children will learn and improve a routine, as well as fitness lessons where children will learn some of the key aspects of circuit training.



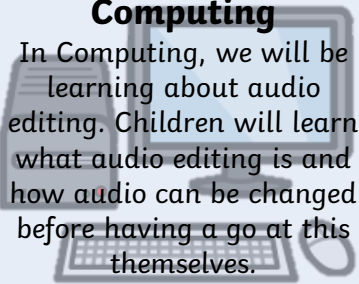
### French

In French, children will recap general classroom language whilst learning how to say what I and others have.



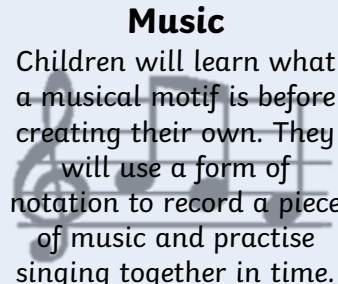
### Computing

In Computing, we will be learning about audio editing. Children will learn what audio editing is and how audio can be changed before having a go at this themselves.



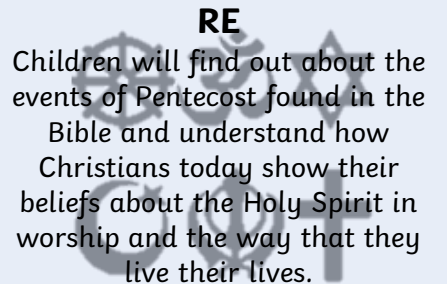
### Music

Children will learn what a musical motif is before creating their own. They will use a form of notation to record a piece of music and practise singing together in time.



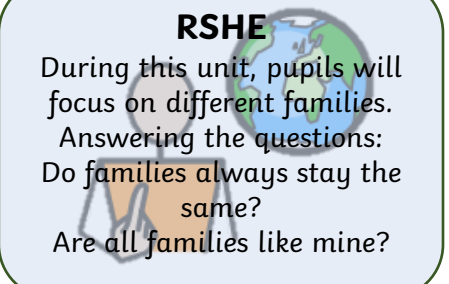
### RE

### Geography

This unit is focused on the continent of Europe. Children will locate counties and capitals in Europe, recognise physical and human features and use this to compare countries. Finally, children will look at the Mediterranean sea and why this is important for countries, including trade.
