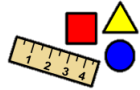

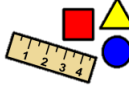
English

The learning journey will develop children's understanding of the story – its characters, themes and language. Pupils will make connections on a personal level with Edward, a china rabbit, who is on a journey of self-discovery.

Maths

Children will learn all about fractions, what numerators and denominators mean, how to compare them and convert them. Children will then progress onto completing calculations with fractions. Children will also learn about mass and capacity, comparing and adding and subtracting.



Design Technology

Children will explore South American style foods. They will also learn the skills of grating, slicing and mixing.

Science

Children will learn about the different states of matter and what processes can change these. They will then link this to the water cycle.

PE

Children will continue their learning on invasion games through playing football and striking and fielding games through playing rounders. They will practise skills of dribble, strike, catch, kick, run and dodge.

French

Children will learn how to say how many things, numbers and describing these.

Computing

Children will collect data as well as access data captured over long periods of time. They will look at data points, data sets, and logging intervals.

Music

Children will be taking part in Ukulele lesson from the Derbyshire Wider Opportunities Music Partnership.

RE

Children will learn about the story of Easter and Good Friday. They will also consider what Christians learn from the story.
