Week 1– w/c 5th January 2026

Can you tell your parents about 'The Rainbow Fish' story? Can you draw a picture of Rainbow Fish? You could add a sparkly scale!

Week 2– w/c 12th January 2026

Can you design and create a merman or mermaid tail? You could draw, paint or collage. Can you include different patterns and textures?

Week 3– w/c 19th January 2026

Can you help your parents sort the recycling from general rubbish? Can you remember why it is important to recycle?

Week 4– w/c 26th January 2026

Can you carry out a traffic survey? Talk with your parents about the types of vehicles that pass near your home? Can you count them?
