Week 1– w/c 1st June 2026

Can you tell your parents about 'The Gruffalo's Child'?
Can you remember who the Gruffalo's child was afraid of?
Did she really need to be afraid?

Week 2– w/c 8th June 2026

Can you count to 100? Count out loud with your grown up while walking up and down the stairs. Count how many claps or jumps you can do.

Week 3– w/c 15th June 2026

Can you make a star? You could simply use paper or cardboard. Alternatively, you could use play doh or salt dough. Remember to decorate it bright and shiny!

Week 4– w/c 22nd June 2026

Can you tell your parents about our trip to Matlock Farm Park? Which animals did you see? What was your favourite part of the day? You could draw and label a picture!

Week 5- w/c 29th June 2026

Can you create a dinosaur egg? You could papier mache a balloon or bowl. Once dry, it can be painted. If you have any dinosaur figures you could hide them inside!

Week 6—w/c 6th July 2026

Can you make a junk model dinosaur or volcano? You could use recyclable materials like egg cartons, cardboard boxes, toilet roll tubes etc.

Week 7—w/c 13th July 2026

Go on a nature walk. Can you spot signs of Summer? Talk to your parents about it. Collect twigs, leaves and flowers. Can you make a nature crown with them?

Please continue to listen to your child read their phonics book daily. By the end of this half term, we will have introduced a number of consonant blends and tricky words– Mr, Mrs, once, love, and one- your child needs to be able to read these words by sight which will support fluency and comprehension.
